RULES:

kata:

- only one member of kata team may be younger. Participation of mix team is not allowed.
- in first 3 groups ('98, '99 and '00 & younger) only elementary kata is allowed, the kata may be repeated, but not in the row.
- in groups IV and V ('97 & '96) yellow and orange (I and II level) only elementary kata is allowed, the kata may be repeated, but not in the row. Competitors in other levels may perform only elementary katas, the kata may not be repeated, and in the finals competitor may perform also kata from official WKF list.
- in groups VI and VII ('95 & '94) yellow-orange (I level) only elementary kata is allowed, the kata may be repeated, but not in the row. Competitors in other levels may perform elementary kata, or kata from official WKF list, but the kata may not be repeated.
- in groups VIII, IX and X ('93-'91) competitors may perform kata from their choice.
- in groups XI, XII and XIII (cadets, juniors & seniors) WKF rules.
- in kata team finals Bunkai for group III ('94-'95), group IV ('91-'93) and group V (cad-jun) is obliged.

kumite:

- protective equipments is necessary for kumite , protective gloves, teeth protect and belts (red and blue) is personal equipment.
- kumite team (male or female) comprise of 3+1 competitors in open category, except for juniors male the team comprise of 5+2 competitors
- in groups IV and V ('97 & '96) duration of bout is 1 minute, in groups VI & VII ('95 & '94) duration of bout is 1,5 minutes, and in all other groups duration of bout is 2 minutes, except for seniors duration of bout is 3 minutes.
