# **Entries:**

The CKF have agreed the competitors from the age of 7 years old can participate in Kumite and Kata.

At 16 years and above WKF rules will apply. Should the entries permit, we will endeavor to have a team, champions league style format, were teams will have a round robin in their section and the top 2 from each group go through to the latter stages. There are no limits on any entries as this is an open CKF championship. Countries may have more than one individual or team in any relevant category.

# ENTRY CLOSING DATE 9th MAY 2008

The SKGB invites and welcomes you to participate in the above CKF Championship. This kumite and kata competition will be open to Children 8-15 years, cadets 16 and 17 years old and adults 18 years and above. All cadet and adult categories will be held on Saturday 31<sup>st</sup> MAY followed by children's events on Sunday 1<sup>st</sup> JUNE 2008.

#### Kata

In the children's Kata events any kata can be performed and repeated in subsequent rounds. For adults competing in the kata event WKF rules apply. Entry fees are as follows:

#### Kumite - Individual and Team Events

Children's kumite (8-15 years) all bouts will be of a two minute duration. Cadet and adult kumite WKF rules apply. Team kumite, each team should consist of three members, for the children's team events all members should be from the same category.
