AGE GROUPS

U 10: Kata individual (male, female) Kata team (mixed);

U 12: Kata individual (male, female) Kata team (mixed);

U 14: Kata individual (male, female) Kata team (mixed);

Kumite individual (male, female) –155cm/+155cm

U 16: Kata individual (male, female) Kata team (mixed);

Kumite individual (male -57kg/+57kg, female -55kg/+55kg)

U 18: Kata individual (male, female) Kata team (mixed);

Kumite individual (male –65kg/+65kg, female –57kg/+57kg)

U 21: Kata individual (male, female) Kata team (mixed);

Kumite individual (male –70kg/+70kg, female –60kg/+60kg)

U 100: Kata individual (male, female) Kata team (mixed);

<u>limits of graduation:</u> Kata individual A, general class: from 3rd Kyu

Kata individual B, general class: until 4th Kyu

Beyond it there are no limits in grade in the KATA competitions, but the KATA according to the rules (s.b.) must be known.

Kumite U14, U 16, U 18: 6th Kyu Kumite U 21, general class: 3rd Kyu

age limits:

Deadline for the forming part of age groups is May 30th 2008.

minimum age general class (A+B) Kata: 16 years

Participants of the classes U 18 and U 21 can also take part in this category.

minimum age general class Kumite: 18 years

Participants of the classes U 21 can also take part in this category.

minimum age U 100: 35 years.

In the team competitions it is possible to take part in an other age class; the oldest participant of the team has to decide the forming part of the group. Every man/woman is allowed to start in only one team.

rules Kata:

according to ESKA Contest Rules 1995 with adaptions

individual competitions:

As a matter of principle the "Flag-System" (2 participants side by side) is given. The main-referee decides the Kata being shown. So 2 men/women reach the final, 2 further finalists are determined in a consolation contest.

In the elimination rounds there are the following Kata:

U 10, U 12, U 14, U 16, general class B: Taikyoku 1, Heian 1-3 U 18, U 21, U 100, general class A: Heian 1-5, Tekki 1

With U 18, U 21, U 100 and the general class Jion and Kanku Dai are given in the quarter-final and semi final (from 8 to 4 starters, from 4 to 2 starters), and also for the last 2 rounds of the consulation contest.

Final (4 participants): awarding of points with Kata of free choice.

team contests:

Male, female and mixed teams start in one category. Awarding of points is used and with 4 teams and more a preliminary round is necessary.

rules Kumite :

WKF-rules

If there are many participants they have to fight according to their bodyheight or wight (classes U 14 - U 21). fighting time: 2 minutes - until U16 without 10 second rule

WKF Protective equipment obligatory:

fist protectors, chestprotector, foot- and cnemialprotectors, and gumschields.

general rules:

Every Austrian participant must show a valid ÖKB licence with actual year-sign. Foreign participants must have a valid licence issued by their home-association.

The organizer decides on combining competitions after having entries.
