# **COMPETITION GUIDELINES**

## <u>Kata</u>

For Categories 36 to 41 any Kata may be performed. You must not however repeat a Kata . Category 42 to 45 any kata but a 1 in 3 i.e Yondan, then Sandan then Yondan etc but must be different in the final. In Team Kata category 46, Bunkai must be performed by the two Finalists.

## <u>Kumite</u>

Full WKF rules, except in the teams and Snr Opens where 16yrs and above will fight with the contact rule, the 15yrs and below categories will fight with the none contact rule.

Please ensure that your sheets are filled in correctly. i.e. Name, Sex, Your Exact Weight, Age, Grade. Mark the event(s) you are entering in the boxes on the entry form, i.e. Any of the numbers 1 to 46 off the category list, Enter total amount payable per competitor and Licence Number.

- Entry forms **must be** signed by the official Association or Club coach only. Entry forms with out a signed declaration, will not be permitted to take part in the championships.
- The first event will be Jnr Kata which will commence at 09.30hrs on all areas, Followed by Snr Kata and Team Kata. Jnr Ind Kumite will start from 11-00am, followed by Jnr Team Kumite. Youth Kumite will commence from 1400hrs. Snr Team Kumite will follow the Youths Kumite Snr Individual Kumite, will commence between 1500-1530hrs.
  N.B Snrs in Ind kumite will not start before 1500hrs.
- Cost of entries: Individuals are from £ 13 per event, Team Kata/Kumite £21 per team, Check category list for the correct category number.

- Children's Teams are 15yrs and under, and split into two age divisions, there are no height restriction, so please be aware smaller children may be drawn against a taller child. This year we have also split the boys from the Girls.
- The minimum number of competitors per event category and the cancellation of events is at the discretion of the organisers
- Full amount to be sent with entry form, before 1<sup>st</sup> May 2008 after this date entries will not be processed. <u>No late entries on the day.</u>
- All clubs are asked to bring a **Referee/Judge or a Time Keeper/Recorder** who's names must be entered on the slip over leaf. They will be given free entry on the day for their service's, plus refreshments.
- **Timekeepers** and **Recorders** must sign in at the control table on arrival and then report to their area tables to register the first events.
- All officials willing to referee on the day, should contact the Organiser on Tel: 01617971077 or ama.sensei@btopenworld.com before the 01/05/08, to get an update of any change's to the rules. A Gratuity will be paid to all Qualified Association Officials for their services,
- Only the **official coach** on duty that day may approach the control table for any queries, competitors and spectators must go via their coach for information.

• **Spectators** entry fees are **£8 and £5** which you pay at the Spectators entrance where you will receive a wristband. Spectators must not pose has coaches, and must not be on the control side of the areas. There are no cameras or video equipment allowed on or around the mats or again on the control table side you are to use a Camera or Video Recorder from the spectator area you must apply for a pass form, giving your Name and address so we may register it for use. A pass will be allocated for its use. There will be a small charge, which is £5. This must also be sent with the entry form. This fee is purely to cover costs of admin and issuing of a badge for the day.

• The St Johns Ambulance will be providing medical cover on the day.

• All Students who are competing must be fully insured by their Association and must have their licences at hand to be checked on the day if required.

• All competitors should be aware that the events are run to WKF rules. Slight amendments by the Organisers may be necessary for a safe running of the championships. Competitors event tickets and will be required when you register at the tables for each event, they will have your event and which area you should be on , these must be checked when you receive them via your coach.

• Bags and belongings must not be left unattended, around the areas. There are lockers in the changing rooms for everyone's valuables, please use them.

• Any spectator/competitor or coach infringing the above rules will be asked to leave the sports hall, no refund will be given, and the name of the club concerned will be reported to their association and their governing body. Shikkaku may be invoked when a contestant or delegations act in a way which harms the prestige and honour of Karate-do. We do try to run events to time but unfortunately all competitions do experience slight problems. Your help and attention is needed on all the above points, so everyone may enjoy a safe and enjoyable day.

WKF rules will apply on the day (as per AMA/EKF guidelines, there may be amendments at the discretion of the organiser).

Any known style <u>Kata</u> will be allowed for Jnr 4<sup>th</sup> kyu and below and the 9yrs and under. All Jnr 3<sup>rd</sup> Kyu and above and Snrs will compete as per WKF rules except their will be no compulsory kata, the Snr 4<sup>th</sup> Kyu mixed category is also any kata.

Team Kata is Open (With bunkai) <u>Team Kumite</u> you must be registered to the club or Association you are competing for and you must list all team members names on the entry form.

Gum shields, clean GI's are compulsory, Chest guards (girls) and groin boxes are recommended. <u>No</u> <u>T-Shirts or Kick Boxing Type Equipment</u> is Allowed. The New Kumite mitt is compulsory in Red & <u>Blue</u>. Red and Blue belts are also compulsory as per WKF rules. Please mark them with your Club or Name. Foot & Shin guards for 16yrs and above are compulsory and optional for 15yrs and under
