

Explanation of the number of teams allowed that correspond to the number of regions assigned: <u>Example with 3 regions assigned:</u>

The alternatives of participations are:

- 3 different regions, each bringing 4 teams.
- 12 different regions, each bringing 1 team.

Between these two limits, all other participation combinations are possible with the only condition that **one region cannot participate with more than 1 team per category**.

#### **Example with 1 region assigned:**

The possible alternatives of participations are the following:

- 1 region bringing 4 teams,
- 2 regions, each bringing 2 teams,
- 3 regions, each bringing 1 team and 1 bringing 2 teams,
- 4 regions, each bringing 1 team.

There is always the limitation of no more than 1 team per region and category, except for the Host National Federation, who will agree with the EKF on its participation figures.
