The Sport Hall

<u>Peace and Friendship Stadium</u> is located at N. Faliro coastal region, a top transportation junction, just 4 kms from the port of Piraeus, 10 kms from the city centre and 25 kms from "Eleftherios Venizelos" airport, with an easy access by all public transport means (METRO, bus, tram e.t.c).

It was constructed the period between 1981-1984 by Greek companies. The study was accomplished by "Thimios Papagiannis and Partners" office.

It is a characteristic sample of the 20th century latest architectural style. It also presents many similarities to the Arena of Milan and the Palais of Budapest.



The City of Athens

Athens, the capital and largest city of Greece, dominates the Attica peripheryas one of the world's oldest cities, its recorded history spans at least 3,000 years.

The municipality of Athens has a population of 745,514 with metropolitan population of 3.2 million. The actual, however, is believed to be higher, because during census-taking (carried out everv 10 years) once Athenians residents travel back to their birthplaces, and register as local citizens there.



Reflective this uncertainly about population figures, various sources refer to a population of around 5 million people for Athens (without counting the foreigners).

A bustling and cosmopolitan metropolis, Athens is central to economic, financial, industrial, political and cultural life in Greece. It is rapidly becoming a leading business centre in the European Union.

The ancient site of the city is centered on the rocky hill of the acropolis. All of those who visit Athens never miss to see this spectacular site of Athens.

Athens enjoys a typical Mediterranean climate, with the greatest amounts of precipitation mainly occurring from mid-October to mid-April, any precipitation is sparse during summer and falls generally in the form of showers and/or thunderstorms.



Visas for Foreigners Travelling to Greece

- 1. Greece follows the Schengen Agreement provisions and the subsequent acquis concerning short term visa issues. Countries applying the Schengen acquis in full (EU countries: Austria, Belgium, Denmark, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Italy, Luxembourg, The Netherlands, Portugal, Spain, Sweden, plus associated countries: Iceland and Norway) follow a common visa policy for short-term stays of up to three (3) months in the Schengen area. The citizens of these countries are not subjected to border controls within the common area (airlines or other carriers require identification I.D. Card or passport or any other piece of identification issued by a public authority)
- 2. Citizens of the following EU and other European countries do not need a visa to enter Greece (and the Schengen area). They have only to produce a passport or an I.D. card at the border.

Bulgaria, Cyprus, Czech Republic, Estonia, Ireland, Latvia, Lichtenstein, Lithuania, Hungary, Malta, Poland, Romania, Slovakia, Slovenia, Switzerland, United Kingdom

3. For holders of **regular passports** of the following countries who wish to visit Greece (and the Schengen area) and stay up to 3 months (90 days) within a six (6) month period, **NO visa is required**:

Andorra, Argentina, Australia, Brazil, Brunei Darussalam, Canada, Chile, Costa Rica, The Holy See (Vatican), Croatia, El Salvador, Guatemala, Honduras, Israel, Japan, Malaysia, Mexico, Monaco, New Zealand, Panama, Paraguay, San Marino, Singapore, South Korea, USA, Uruguay, Venezuela, Nicaragua.

4. <u>Holders of regular passports from the rest of the world need a visa</u> in order to enter Greece (and the Schengen area).

NOTE: When travelling to Greece on a tourist visa, visitors are required to have travel insurance that covers cases of medical or other emergencies for the duration of the **stay**.
