 $\checkmark$  A doctor's permission to take part in the competition

✓ Full Insurance coverage for all eventualities.

The entry fee must be paid in cash before the beginning of competition

The Grand Prix competitions will be conducted according to rules of WKF (with changes)- two third places, flag system in kata and kumite competitions with play-offs.

The competition will take place on 4-5 areas (tatami).

Contestants who start in kumite are obliged to have necessary equipment (WKF design)

- $\checkmark$  teeth guard
- ✓ groin guards
- ✓ feet guards
- ✓ gloves

There is no obligation to present bunkai by kata teams in final for children and abecedarians (obligatory for Cadets, Juniors, Seniors).

Every club can appoint a free number of competitors and teams .

In kata competitions for children ( to 9 years old) minimum two kata have to be done alternatively.

In kata competitions for children (10 - 11 years old) minimum two kata have to be done alternatively (during contest for a medal different kata have to be done except Taikyokushodan)

In kata competitions of Abecedarians in every round different kata have to be done (from H-2, P-2 or from WKF list )

Cadets, juniors, seniors - WKF rules !

In teams kata for children ( to 8 years old) there is no obligation to present different kata.

In teams kata for children ( 9 - 11 years old) minimum two kata have to be done alternatively.

In teams kata of Abecedarians in every round different kata have to be done. In teams kata of Cadets, Juniors, Seniors - WKF rules !

AWARDS	Competitors who are first in the individual contests will receive memorial cups, medals and diplomas. For 2nd and 3rd places they will receive memorial medals and diplomas. For the first place in the team contests, the winning team will get a memorial cup, medals and diplomas. For 2nd and 3rd places they will receive memorial medals and diplomas.			
MISCELLANEOUS	All controversial matters will be solved by the Main Judge of the competition in agreement with the organizer. The organizer isn't responsible for lost items . Heads of teams are resposible for			

	competitors' behaviour or eventual damages made by them.		
	During the competition only competitors, heads of teams, coaches and invited guests can stay in the area of a fighting floor. For the audience there are special places.		
	In order to lodge a protest against judges decision it is necessary to pay security at the amount of PLN 200 ( $\in$ 50) .		
	Exhibition and sale of goods is allowed on condition that the organizer gives his consent to it.		
	It is also possible to order a tasty meal in the area of Sports hall for a cheap price.		
ACCOMODATION	Organizer of Grand Prix can book an accommodation for teams which put in an order until 11.10.2010r. Payment for accommodation must be paid in cash in organizer's office. After 11.10.2010r. organizer don't provide an accommodation.
