WELCOME TO BELGRADE

Belgrade, just like other European cities, has its old and new face, its mementos of the past and the joys of youth. But what makes cities, and indeed the people different here is their soul and appearance, their charm and openness make them special. The beauty of our town is in the smile of its people, their spontaneity and warmth, a friendly and extended hand most sincerely saying – Come again!

Belgrade is a special town – an endless story never reaching the epilogue because of its long, rich and, above all, turbulent history which has left its marks, but also a unique soul created in the richness of differences and spiritual traces. In addition to Athens, Belgrade is one of the oldest European cities, and the culture of Vinča is one of the oldest cultures of the continent.

The Belgrade time machine would bring us straight to the heart of the Belgrade Fortress, the place which seems to have been the cornerstone of all events happening in the town's life – historical, political, social, cultural ... and today it is a popular place for walks and art gatherings. This is how it has been for centuries, and this is how it is today.

Famous Prince Mihailova Street is close to the Belgrade Fortress and is the town's artery. You may measure it either in meters or in the people you meet, the favorite places and long-standing institutions. Never deserted people passing or walking, street performers, and ladies window-shopping together are just a part of its everyday face. It was first acknowledged as a street centuries ago, and it developed together with Belgrade. Many of its restaurants, hotels and shops are mentioned in the town's chronicles, and there are always new noteworthy places yet to be recorded. The street has both common popular places as well as those each of us feels to be special. The first group is in the city map; the places belonging to the second group are engraved in the hearts of the people living in Belgrade.

The street will lead you to Trg Republike, the square hosting the town's most famous monument – Prince Mihailo. The square is bordered by two major cultural institutions – the National Museum and National Theatre.

Just a few hundred meters from the town's central square, its lively and eventful mood fades away. If you feel like seeing a relaxed Belgrade, the best choice is to go to Skadarlija, the town's bohemian quarter, the street of cafés and restaurants, a popular place enjoyed by the people of Belgrade and their guests. Time seems to have stopped here, and the hasty everyday life is won over by Skadarlija's relaxed setting and the aged spirit of the town living another life surrounded by old houses. If you miss going to Skadarlija and its atmosphere, you can hardly feel the genuine soul of the town and the people living in it. It is a street of the past and nostalgia is felt for foregone times, and it has the quality of stopped time for us and for our sake. Depending on the occasion and taste, on your mood and the time of day, you may choose the environment and menu in one among many of Skadarlija's restaurants. One thing will never vary: a recognizable homemade taste.

And when you feel like escaping from the city clamor and everyday pressures, there is no need to go far. At no more than 4 km from central Belgrade, you will find Ada Ciganlija, the most popular resort for the people of Belgrade and their guests. Its huge green areas, with the lake in the middle, belong to the full list of qualities any town should have to meet the needs of its people. And Belgrade has it. The town with Belgrade's ambitions would not gain much from its colorful streets and squares if it had not a special and peaceful retreat as Ada Ciganlija.

The time spent in these or many other places will make you realize that you have become attached to Belgrade in a special way. Who knows exactly when this extraordinary chemistry happens to spread, but we know that Belgrade is staying with you, and even when you are packing and intend to leave, you will never leave for good. There are always people, towns and places we are saying GOODBYE to, but what we are actually telling them is SEE YOU SOON.

































VISAS

Foreign citizens may enter Serbia with a valid passport and with visas issued by Serbian diplomatic or consular offices abroad.

Citizens of the following countries do not need a visa to enter Serbia:

a) For all types of passport, up to 90 days:

Andorra, Argentina, Australia, Austria, Belgium, Belarus, Bolivia, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Bulgaria, Czech, Chile, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, France, FYROM, Great Britain, Greece, Croatia, Netherlands, Ireland, Iceland, Italy, Israel, Japan, Canada, Cyprus, Cuba, Costa Rica, Latvia, Lichtenstein, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Hungary, Malta, Monaco, Germany, Norway, New Zealand, Poland, Portugal, Republic of Korea, Romania, San Marino, the Seychelles, Singapore, United States of America, Slovakia, Slovenia, Spain, Switzerland, Sweden, Tunisia, the Vatican.

b) For diplomatic and official passports, as well as ordinary passports with the "business in" clause:

Democratic People's Republic of Korea, China, Azerbaijan, Georgia, Armenia, Kyrgyzstan, Mongolia, the Republic of Tajikistan, Ukraine, the Russian Federation, Turkmenistan.

c) Only with diplomatic or official passports:

Ecuador, Pakistan, Guinea, Peru, Turkey.

d) Only with diplomatic passports:

Eavpt.

e) Only with ordinary passports:

Mexico

LANGUAGE

The official language is Serbian. Most of the people speak English.

CURRENCY

The official currency is the dinar (RSD).

Coins: 1, 2, 5, 10 and 20 dinars.

Banknotes: 10, 20, 50, 100, 200, 500, 1000 and 5000 dinars.

Currency can be exchanged in all banks and post offices, as well as in the many authorized exchange offices (exchange offices do not take exchange fees).

Time, electricity and water

Belgrade is in the CET zone - Central European Time (GMT+1 hour).

Summer time is from the end of March to the end of October (GMT+2 hours).

The Serbian electricity network operates at 220 V~, and a frequency of 50 Hz.

The city public water supply and the water from public drinking fountains are safe and pleasant to drink.

WEATHER

Belgrade has a moderate continental climate, with four seasons. Autumn is longer than spring, with longer sunny and warm periods - the so-called Indian summer. Winter is not so severe, with an average of 21 days with temperature below zero. January is the coldest month, with average temperature of 0.1°C. Spring is short and rainy. Summer arrives abruptly.

The average annual air temperature is 11.7°C. The hottest month is July (22.1°C). The lowest temperature in Belgrade was recorded on January 10th, 1893 (-26.2°C), and the highest on August 12th, 1921 and on September 9th, 1946 (41.8°C). From 1888 to 1995 only six days with temperature of over 40°C were recorded. The average annual number of days with temperature higher than 30°C - the so-called tropical days - is 31 and that of summer days with temperature higher than 25°C is 95. Average air temperature in October is 15°C.









TRANSPORTATION

Belgrade Coach Station

The two coach stations (BAS and Lasta) have a total of 80 departure platforms and 20 arrival platforms, with a daily turnover of more than 1,400 coaches.

Belgrade Main Railway Station

An extensive rail network connects Belgrade with all corners of Europe with both day and night services. Serbian Railways recognize the following discount schemes: InterRail, EuroDomino, Rail Plus, Balkan Flexipass, Easy Travel Card, Euro<26, City Star and the Uniform Balkan Tariff. The main railway station is in the center of Belgrade, 3 km away from Arena.

City Public Transportation

Belgrade city public transport is provided through a network of bus, trolleybus and tram routes run by GSP "Beograd" and bus services operated by private bus companies, on around 130 routes. Single tickets can be bought:

- at kiosks marked with a ticket sales sticker
- at GSP points-of-sale

There are also express minibus services which are a little more expensive, but also more comfortable and quicker as they do not stop at every bus-stop.

PRESS ACCREDITATION:

Press accreditation can only be given to persons who apply for such in advance.

TRAINING FACILITIES:

The organizers will provide the National Federations, which turn in the relevant application on time, with a place for training. The application must be received before the **May 30th**, **2010**. Transportation to the training area will **only be available from the official hotels**.

INSURANCE:

It is compulsory for all participants and delegation members to effectuate their own medical insurance and personal trip insurance. The Karate Federation of Serbia and World Karate Federation are taking no liability for these concepts.

During the registration each delegation must present the signed insurance form.

ENTRANCE:

Entrance to the Sport Hall will be free of charge.

FAREWELL PARTY:

Information about the Farewell Party will be provided at the Information desk during the Championship.

SPORT VENUE - BEOGRADSKA ARENA



The strategic concept of the investor – city authorities, was that the "Belgrade Arena" becomes a key factor in enriching the total tourist offer of Belgrade, Serbia's Capital, by continuously attracting large audiences to its contents and events. The geographical position of Belgrade has always placed it into the centre of all cultural and sports events in this part of Europe. As such, it serves perfectly for attracting the audience from all the surrounding countries, on the one hand, and presents a challenge for the most prominent artists and athletes to gather together at one single place the largest number of their fans, on the other hand.

The hall, consisting of six levels and boasts a well-structured local network. Everybody agreed that, after the model of US arenas of this type, Belgrade obtained a fantastic facility that opens up endless possiblities and that belongs among the very best of the world arenas. It is most often included among the three most beautiful halls in Europe: San Giorgio in Barcelona, Oaku in Athens, and Globen in Stockholm.

Those who have seen the sports hall in Prague say that it is the only match for the Arena in respect of its modern appearance, state-of-art equipment, excellent architectural solution, and, nowadays unavoidable, VIP boxes with all the elements that accompany a special form of luxury that is implicit to the today's sports, entertainment and show business. When it comes to sports, Belgrade now has a facility of which it can be proud.









About "Belgrade Arena"

"Belgrade Arena" became Belgrade's trademark and one of the new symbols of the Serbian capital, as well as the place of interest for the visitors to our capital and the country. It is a facility that fully meets the latest standards and, together with the "Prague Arena", it is at the highest technological level in Europe. This extraordinary building was the work of architect Vlada Slavica, and the investor was the Belgrade City Assembly Secretariat for Sports and Youth.

The Belgrade Arena complex consists of three units: a large hall, a small hall, and the parking space.

The large hall covers the area of 48 000 m2 and has six levels, the seating capacity of 20 000 - 25 000, depending on the event to be held.

The small hall covers the area of 2 275 m2 on two levels; the over-all dimensions of the hall are 30 x 60m and it serves as the ancillary facility that is used for athletes' preparation and training. It was designed as the facility where the athletes can warm up and then, through the underground pedestrian walkway, under the road on the South, go to the large hall. The field in the small hall is $29.20m \times 43.70m$ and the height of the hall is 10m. It is possible to divide it into two basketball fields (with wall mounted basketball hoops). With all its ancillary facilities (4 dressing-rooms, café bar, gym, reception desk, and 1 cargo lift connecting these two levels), it can operate as a completely independent unit.

Since its official start in 2007 "Belgrade Arena" hosted most respectable concerts, family shows and sport events, including Eurovision Song Contest, Universiade, Davis Cup and Fed Cup, World Basketball League, Volleyball World League, Disney On Ice, Night Of The Jumps, Job Fair, European Arena's congress ...










CITY MAP
