junior (15 yrs under height and grade) is in the right category event on entry form (1 to 55)

FEES INDIVIDUAL FEES £15.00 per PERSON AND TEAM FEES £20.00 or £30.00 per TEAM

Enter total amount payable per competitor. Full amount must be sent with entry forms,

There will be no refund if the competitor has been entered into the wrong event.

Email and faxed entries will be accepted, but payment must be paid by the **CLOSING DATE**

Please send all entries and money in by the **(CLOSING DATE) one week before competition**
