# **REGULATIONS - 11 KARATE**

Nota Bene: All the information contained in the herewith current regulations is valid at the moment of publishing but may subject to variations.



# **Updated 1<sup>st</sup> of August version**

For all which is not specifically prospected in the current regulations, the W.K.F. (World Karate Federation - Kata and Kumite Competition Rules) are valid and applied.

#### **ENTRIES**

The spirit of the European Master games is that all entries be free and that the athletes do not represent their country of origin, therefore, as a consequence athletes from outside Europe are allowed to subscribe to the games.

# Membership to a Sports Federation

All athletes:

- have to give proof of being members of their National Federation acknowledged and associated to the W.K.F. (World Karate Federation).
- they must have an up-to-date medical certificate which declares the athlete's fitness to compete in the discipline of Karate sports discipline (not requested to Italian participants who already possess a medical certificate as members of the sport chosen).

All Italian athletes who are members of Sports Organizations acknowledged by the CONI and regulated by the FIJLKAM can participate.

## Anti doping

All athletes accept to undergo anti doping tests which will be carried out according to the rules and regulations of the IMGA-WADA.

# Insurance policy

- All the athletes who do not possess the EHIC membership (European Health Insurance Card) must take out an accident insurance policy. Information can be found on the site <a href="http://ehic.europa.eu">http://ehic.europa.eu</a>

# **Entry terms and conditions**

- All athletes must accept the entry terms and conditions, the specified rules and regulations, moreover, they must sign, on registration, release from civil liability.

#### Visa

# 4.2.1 Weight categories

Men: kg 60, kg 67, kg 75, kg 84, kg +84 Women: kg 50, kg 55, kg 61, kg 68, kg +68

The games will be held in the two both male and female combat specialities (Kumite) and (Kata).

4.3. Duration of the combats

4.3.1 Men Kumite: 35+ - 45+ : two minutes

50+ - 55 over: two minutes

4.3.2 Women Kumite: 35+ - 45+: two minutes

50+ - 55 over: two minutes

#### 4.4 Weight check up

All the athletes, when they are being weighed, must exhibit a valid identity card, with a photo (passport or identity card) and also the membership card to the National Federation acknowledged by the WKF.

#### 4.4.1 Scales for the weight check up

Scales respect the technical requirements according to the regulations of the W.K.F..

Athletes who need to check their weight before the competitions may do this in the pertinent rooms for weight control.

# 4.5 Participation

There are no limits at registration, therefore every athlete can participate in the games foreseen for his/her category and age group.

## 5. Training

- 5.1. The sports facilities for training sessions are available on Monday 12<sup>th</sup> Sept. 2011 and on Saturday 17<sup>th</sup> Sept. 2011 inside the GE.TUR. Tourist Village in Lignano Sabbiadoro, Viale Centrale n. 29.
- 5.2 The timetable for the training sessions will be notified further on. Booking for training can be carried out at the SIC at the Accreditation Centre.

# 6. Competitions: standards and rules

6.1. The organization and the management of the Karate games of the European Masters Games in Lignano 2011 will be held under the supervision of the National Sports Federation (FIJLKAM) and will be carried out according to the regulations and rules of the International Federation (W.K.F.) and of the International Masters Games Association (I.M.G.A.).

## 6.3. Technical meeting

The Technical meeting will be held on Tuesday 14.09.2011 at 10.00 a.m. at the Palazzetto Polifunzionale at the GE.TUR. Further information will be notified after the registration deadline of the European Masters Games Lignano 2011 on the site www.lignano2011.it and available at the SIC at the Accreditation Centre.

## 6.4. Jury and Umpires

The competition will be directed by an Umpire and by nominated jury members.

#### 6.5. Registration and medals

In the case the number of participants be insufficient in one of the categories/age groups, the categories/age groups will be formed in a different way in order to allow the competition to be carried out. The awarding of medals will in no way be influenced, that is, athletes will be awarded medals in the age category/class in which they originally entered.

#### 6.6. Prize giving ceremonies

According to the European Masters Games spirit, entries are free and athletes do not represent their country. Consequently, prize giving ceremonies will be carried out without hoisting the flag and without playing the winner's National Anthem.

The first four of each competition and age group will be awarded a medal. can bear the title of "European Masters Games Lignano 2011 Champion".

# 7 Equipment

The following safeguards are compulsory for the Kumite competitions:

- Gloves approved by the W.K.F., one competitor will wear red gloves, and the other blue;
- Gumshield;
- Chest-shield approved by the W.K.F.
- Shin-quard approved by the W.K.F. one competitor will wear red shin-quards, and the other blue;
- Foot-shield approved by the W.K.F. one competitor will wear red foot-shields, and the other blue;
- WKF Body protector

La protection cup is not compulsory, but if it is worn, it must be approved by the WKF.

#### Outfits

- 8.1 Athletes must wear a white Karate-gi. The emblem or the National flag of one's nation can be worn on the front of the jacket and it must not be bigger than 12 cm by 8 cm (consult appendix 9 of the W.K.F. regulations). Only the original tags of the maker are allowed on the gi. Besides, on the back of the jacket, one will wear an identification number supplied by the Organizing Committee. A red belt will be worn by one of the competitors, and a blue one by the other. The red and blue belts must be five centimeters wide and sufficiently long so as to stick out fifteen centimeters on each side of the knot
- 8.2 The Organizing Committee may allow, in deviation from the above paragraph 8.1, the display of special tags or authorized sponsor brands.
- 8.3 The racket, once it has been fastened around the waist by the belt, must hang along the hips for a sufficient minimum length so as to cover them, but it must not be longer than three quarters of the hip. Female competitors may wear a white T-shirt under the Karate jacket
- 8.4 The sleeves of the racket must be long enough so as to cover more than half the forearm, and they must not be longer than the wrist. Folding up one's sleeves is not allowed.
- 8.5 Trousers must be long enough to cover at least two third of the shin-bone, but must not be longer than the ankle and cannot be folded up.
- 8.6 Athletes must keep their hair clean and must have it cut so as not to hazard the normal execution of the competition. The Hachimaki (scarf worn around the head) is not allowed. If the Umpire considers a competitor's hair too long and/or dirty, he/she may disqualify the competitor from the game. Hair clips are forbidden, as also are metal hair pins. It is forbidden to wear ribbons and other ornaments. Very
- 8.7 Athletes must wear their nails short and must not wear metal objects as these may hurt their opponents. The use of metal bites for teeth must be approved by the Umpire and the Official Doctor. The competitor is totally responsible for any wound he/she may cause to the opponent.

#### 9. Registration
