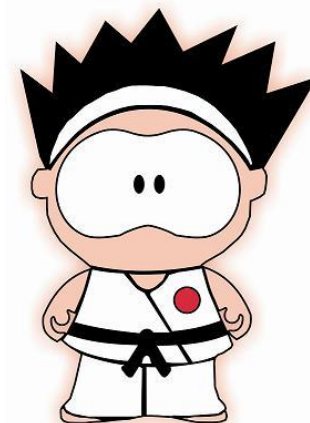

- Senior: 25 Euros.

- If the competitor want to compite in Kata and Kumite will pay for the second participation 10 Euros in addition.

- **FEE TEAM KATA COMPETITION:**

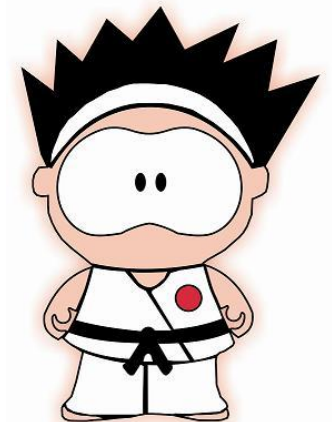
- All the teams will pay 20 Euros for participate (fee for all the team).

- The organizer exclude any form of liability whatsoever.

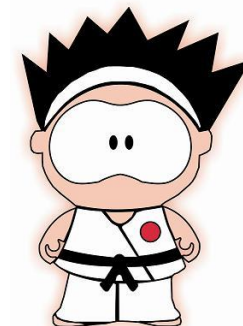


- **EQUIPMENT AND COACH**

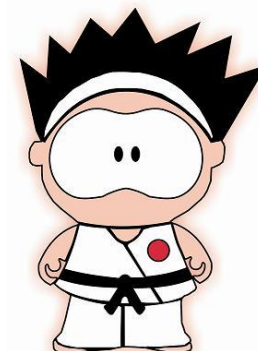
- **IN GENERAL ABOUT THE COMPETITION**
