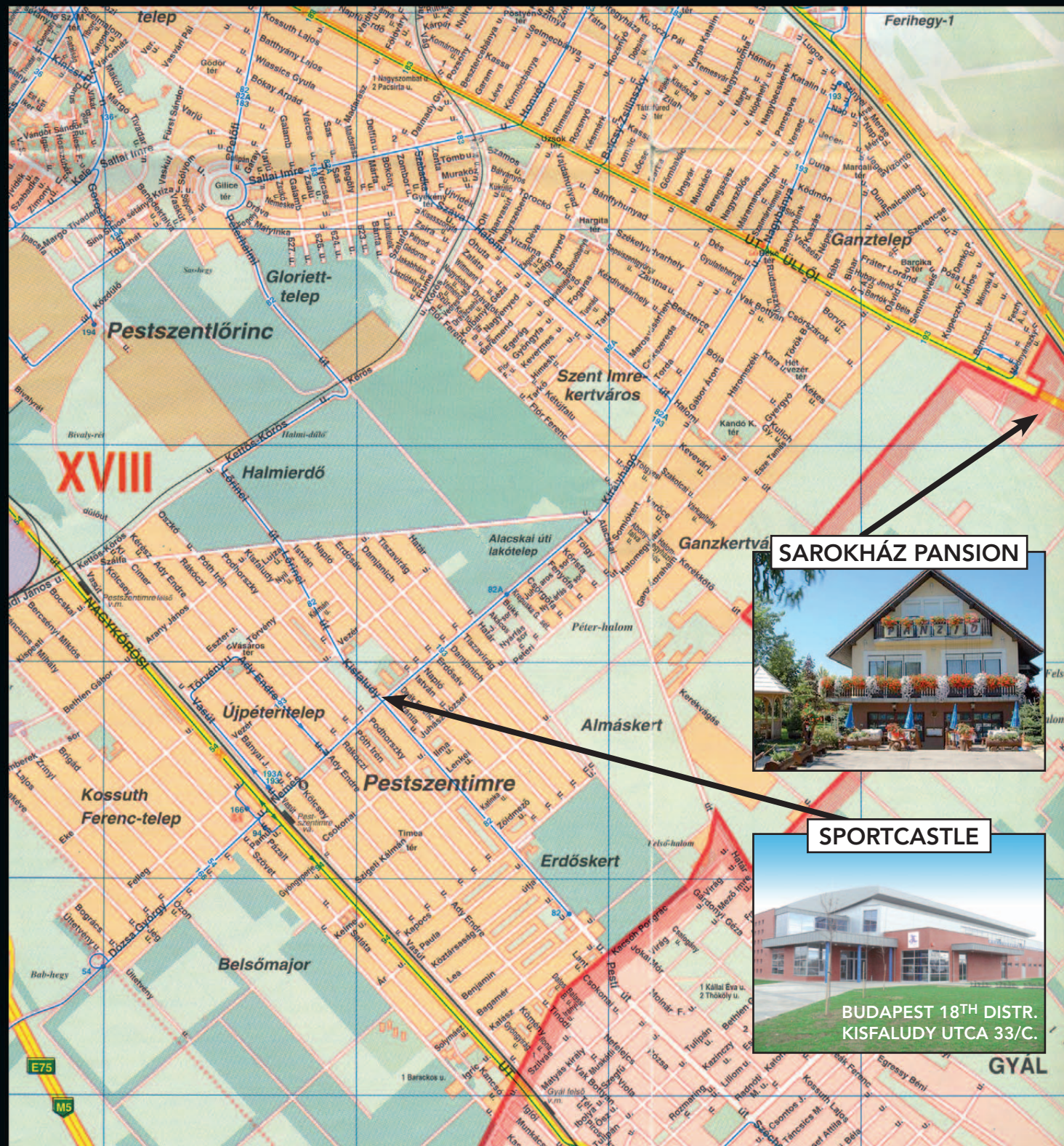

Junior / born between 14th September, 1995 and 15th September, 1997

U 21 / born between 14th September 1992 and 15th September 1995

Senior/ born before 14th September, 1995

COMPETITION CATEGORIES:

Kata individual junior: male – female
Kata individual U 21: male – female
Kata individual senior: male – female

Kumite junior: male -55 kg -61 kg -68 kg -76 kg +76 kg
female -48 kg -53 kg -59 kg +59 kg

Kumite U 21: male -68 kg -76 kg +76 kg
female -53 kg -60 kg +60 kg

Kumite senior: male -60 kg -67 kg -75 kg -84 kg +84 kg
female -50 kg -55 kg -61 kg -68 kg +68 kg

Kumite team: male and female (3+1 competitors)

The teams can be composed from all age categories mentioned above.

RULES:

WKF system. For all kumite competitors body protector is optional.

REGISTRATION:

13th September from 8 pm till 11 pm at the Sporthall, weigh-in for all categories (including boys and girls)

WEIGH IN:

14th September from 7.00 till 8.30 am at the Sportshall, possibility for registration.

ENTRY FEE:

Individual categories 16 Euro
Team kumite 35 Euro

CATEGORIES:

Boys and girls in the following age and weight categories:

8-9 years old boys	-32 kg and +32 kg
8-9 years old girls	-30 kg and +30 kg
10-11 years old boys	-36 kg, -42 kg and +42 kg
10-11 years old girls	-34 kg, -40 kg and +40 kg
12-13 years old boys	-45 kg, -52 kg and +52 kg
12-13 years old girls	-43 kg, -50 kg and +50 kg
Cadet boys	-52 kg, -57 kg, -63 kg -70 kg and +70 kg
Cadet girls	-47 kg, -54 kg and +54 kg

Please, consider the age of the competitors at the date of the tournament!

COMPETITION CATEGORIES: Individual kata and kumite.

RULES:

WKF system with following changes:
short repechage (only 1-1 fight for the two 3rd places)
1,5 minute for kumite, age 8-13, cadets 2 minutes

kata: age 8-9, 10-11
minimum 2 different kata required

age 12-13
minimum 3 different kata required

cadets – WKF system

REGISTRATION/WEIGH IN:

15th September from 7.00 till 8.30 am at the Sportshall.

PROTECTION:

Gum shields, WKF type mitts red and blue, for women chest protection, WKF type shin pads and foot protection red and blue are compulsory. For cadets and younger age groups additionally face mask, for all kumite competitors body protector are optional.

PRIZES:

PROTEST:

The protest has to be submitted in writing to the referee council of the tournament and 50 Euro protest fee has to be deposited. If the protest is accepted by the referee council, the fee is going to be refunded.

Referees are going to be delegated by the Hungarian Karate Federation. Chief referee Mr.Tamás Molnár, WKF – EKF referee. Foreign qualified referees are welcome. Please apply in writing to nominate your referee!
