RULES & REGULATIONS:

The Grand Prix competitions will be conducted according to rules of WKF with two third places, flag system in kata and kumite competitions with play-offs. **The day of birth decides about the age category !**

KATA:

- In teams kata for children (U9 and U12) there is no obligation to present different kata in every round and bunkai in final.
- In kata competition for children (U8, 8 years) there is no obligation to present different kata.
- In kata competitions for children (9 years, 10 years, 11 years) minimum two kata have to be done alternatively.
- In kata competition for children (U14) in every round different kata have to be done (from Heian I-V, Pinian, or from WKF)
- In kata competitions of Cadets, Juniors, Seniors – WKF rules with change - there is no obligation to present bunkai in final !

KUMITE:

- Children Individual Kumite: (U10) – 60 sec. fight, (U12 and U14) – 90 sec. fight.
- In kumite competitions of Cadets, Juniors, Seniors – WKF rules !
- If in weight category will be less than 8 competitors category can be combined.
- In teams kumite competition, team can be complete with competitor from younger age category.

- Contestants who start in kumite are obligated to have necessary equipment (WKF design: teeth guard, groin guard, feet guards and gloves in blue and red colour). In kumite competitions of Cadets, face masks are obligatory ! In kumite competitions of children U14, Cadets, Juniors and Seniors, body protectors are obligatory !

ENTRY FEE: **15 € - one individual contest**
30 € - team contest

AWARDS: **100 € - for 1st place in competitions:**
Kata individual male/female juniors/seniors
Kumite individual male/female juniors/seniors open

Competitors who are first in the individual contests will receive memorial cups, medals and diplomas. For 2nd and 3rd places they will receive memorial medals and diplomas. For the first place in the team contests, the winning team will get a memorial cup, medals and diplomas. For 2nd and 3rd places they will receive memorial medals and diplomas.

CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION:

The competition is open for polish (members of Polish Karate Federation) and foreign clubs (members of EKF or WKF). Each contestant should have: proven karate degree (a diploma, budo-book etc.), identity card with a photo, competitors license, a doctor's permission to take part in the competition and full insurance coverage for all eventualities. All of these documents should be prepared for possible control during competition.

All controversial matters will be solved by the Main Judge of the competition in agreement with the organizer. The organizer isn't responsible for lost items. Heads of teams are responsible for competitors' behaviour or eventual damages made by them. During the competition only competitors, heads of teams, coaches and invited guests can stay in the area of a fighting floor. For the audience there are special places. In order to lodge a protest against judges decision it is necessary to pay security at the amount of PLN 200 (€ 50). Exhibition and sale of goods is allowed on condition that the organizer gives his consent to it. It is also possible to order a tasty meal in the area of Sports hall for a cheap price.
