

 - ♣ Tangier Transportation: Getting around in a new city can be confusing. Here are the best methods of transportation in Tangier.
 - ➤ The train is more spacious than taking the bus. Trains run every thirty minutes. There are two stations. The main station is called Tangier ville. The overhead racks in their tracks are too small to be followed, and leaving them in the aisles can cause issues with the food cart. You can avoid this problem









and be more comfortable by choosing to travel first class, or use our **TGV** service which called Al-Boraq.

- There are two types of taxis in Morocco. (Petit taxis) are small cars, and they are not allowed to go outside of the town limits. They have a special sign on the roof which usually looks like a small box, and they are blue. The other type is a (Grand taxi). These are larger cars, and they can go anywhere you need to go. You can negotiate a price for the trip before you leave, or you can use the meter.
- > There is also defferent companies regarding the bus transportation.
- > Depending on where you are staying, you can find the best way to get around the city.


15. Country Information

MOROCCO

Morocco has a population of over 33.8 million and an area of 446,550 km2 (172,410 sq mi). Its capital is Rabat, and the largest city is Casablanca. Other major cities include Marrakesh, Tangier, Salé, Fes, and Meknes. Moroccan culture is a blend of Arab, indigenous Berber, Sub-Saharan African, and European influences.

Morocco's official languages are Arabic and Berber. The Moroccan dialect, French are also widely spoken. Morocco is a member of the Arab League, the Union for the Mediterranean, and the African Union. It has the fifth largest economy of Africa.

Tourism in Morocco is well developed, with a strong tourist industry focused on the country's coast, culture, and history. Morocco has been one of the most politically stable countries in North Africa, which has allowed tourism to develop. The Moroccan government created a Ministry of Tourism in 1985. Tourism is considered as one of the main foreign exchange sources in Morocco.
