Dear karatekas,

SKIF CZ and Spartak Hradec Králové organize another top SKIF tournament. In addition to the SKIEF European Championship 2017 and the SKIF World Championship 2019, 3 editions of the Grand Prix Hradec Králové have already taken place in Hradec Králové city under SKIF rules: The tournament takes place in the Trebes sports hall, where both sports halls will be available for the tournament

Last year, the sale of the book WCH SKIF 2019 was launched at the Grand Prix Hradec Králové. The book will also be available for purchase at the Grand Prix Hradec Králové 2026 tournament.

The tournament has the same categories as those at SKIF championships so that competitors can prepare in advance for the SKIF World Championship 2026. In addition, weight categories will be announced in youth categories, categories for lower technical grades at the Grand Prix Hradec Králové. Competitors can also take advantage of alternating starts in higher age categories.

The tournament is organized by the SK Karate Spartak Hradec Králové club in cooperation with SKIF CZ and with the support of the city of Hradec Králové and the Hradec Králové region. It is the same organizing team that organized the SKIEF European Championship 2017 and the SKIF World Championship 2019 in Hradec Králové. Therefore, the team that will do everything in 2026 to ensure that all competitors, coaches, referees, and fans of karate who travel to the Grand Prix Hradec Králové 2026 are maximally satisfied with the tournament visit to Hradec Králové and leave with the most pleasant experiences.



wooden Church of the Holy Nicholas.




## **KATA**

- at least 9<sup>th</sup> kyu
- repasage: kohaku system until final 2. All who lost with finalists go to new "repasage" draw again; two competitors who win repasage draw and 2 finalist go together to FINAL 4 for points; one third place
- In kata category consisting of 5-7 contestants there will be semifinal with point system and then the final for the best 4 semifinalists with point system. In kata category consisting of 4 or less contestants there will be directly the final with point system
- SKIF standardization is preferred

## **children (7-13 years)**

- kohaku system: Heian Shodan – Godan selected by referee panel
- final – tokui kata: Heian Shodan – Godan, Tekki-Shodan, Bassai-dai, Jion, Kanku-dai and Empi

## **cadets (14-15 years)**

- kohaku system: Heian Shodan – Godan or Tekki Shodan selected by referee panel
- final – tokui kata: Heian Shodan – Godan, Tekki-Shodan, Bassai-dai, Jion, Kanku-dai, Empi, Gankaku, Jitte, Bassai-sho and Kanku-sho

## **juniors (16-17 years)**

- kohaku system: Heian Shodan – Godan or Tekki Shodan selected by referee panel
- final – tokui kata: all kata allowed (except Seienchin, Seipai, Gankaku-sho and Nijuhachi)

## **U20, seniors**

- kohaku system: Bassai-dai, Jion, Kanku-dai or Empi selected by referee panel
- final – tokui kata: all kata allowed

## **Masters**

- kohaku system: Bassai-dai, Jion
- final – tokui kata: all kata allowed

## **KATA TEAM**

- kata team will be held for 2 rounds, semifinal and final by point system, if there are more than 8 teams. If there is 8 and less teams, there will be 1 round; if there is any draw in semifinal, teams must perform different kata; if there is a draw in final, teams can perform kata from semifinal; so 2 katas must be prepared in total
- children (7-13 years) – Heian Shodan – Godan
- juniors, seniors, masters – all kata allowed
- kata team mix (masters) – males, females and mixed teams together, U50 and 50+ together

# RULES - KUMITE & TEAMS

Tournament with SKIEF rules with details mentioned below



## **KUMITE & KUMITE TEAM**

- at least 8<sup>th</sup> kyu
- all categories – Ippon Han Shobu
- children and cadets (7-15 years) – match of 90 seconds
- juniors, U20, seniors, Masters – match 120 seconds
- Repasage: kohaku system until final; all who lost with finalists go to new "repasage" draw again; two competitors who win "repasage" draw are third. There are two 3<sup>rd</sup> places to win.
- The kumite category is primarily intended for competitors from 6th kyu. Competitors from 8th kyu may also enter this discipline at their own risk, but with the risk that this discipline will clash with disciplines intended for competitors up to 7th kyu in the schedule.
- team – 3+1 competitors
- protectors: Gum shield, Mitts (approved by SKIF) are compulsory (red and blue mitts are allowed); Groin and Chest (Girls) protectors are recommended, but Shin protectors are forbidden; Body protectors are recommended for children's and cadet's categories (7-15 years)

## **YAKUSOKU KUMITE INDIVIDUAL (children)**

- system is same as in kumite. Individuals (not teams) are competing against each other in kohaku system with repasage
- gohon kumite – each competitor must do five attacks jodan oi-zuki and five attack chudan oi-zuki; each competitor must demonstrate one defending technique on each type of attack (so one defending technique five times)
- sanbon kumite – each competitor must do three attacks: jodan oi-zuki, chudan oi-zuki, chudan mae-geri; each competitor must demonstrate one defending technique on each attack
- kihon ippon kumite, jiyu ippon kumite – each competitor must do five attacks: jodan oi-zuki, chudan oi-zuki, chudan mae-geri, chudan yoko-geri-kekomi, jodan mawashi-geri; each competitor must demonstrate one defending technique on each attack; each competitor must demonstrate different defending techniques
- SKIF defending techniques are preferred

## **YAKUSOKU KUMITE TEAM (Masters)**

- competition of pairs (2 competitors complete as one team)
- one club can have more jakusoku kumite teams
- yakusoku kumite for seniors and masters will be held according to Article 16, page 18-19 of SKIEF competition Rules 2.1:

- one category mixed together, teams consisting of 2 competitors (male, female and mixed together)
- preliminary rounds - Kohaku system with repasage same as KATA - Kihon ippon kumite
- final 4 - point system - Jiyu ippon kumite
